

SFFSC Fundraising Requirements & Opportunities



Requirements

Home Club Members: \$150 per family

A check for the required amount is due to SFFSC by **9/15/22**. The checks from families who raise the required amount will be shredded. Families will be responsible for any balance due if the required amount is not met. Please place checks in black mailbox on the wall near the south rink or mail to (4300 N Bobhalla Dr. SF, SD 57107) - Skaters will **NOT** be permitted to skate prior to submitting all required checks.

Members will be allowed to pay for any shortages until May 6,2023. Fundraising checks will be cashed for the full amount if the minimum is not met or shortage paid by May 9th 2023.

- Sell message bubbles to friends and family who want to leave fun and caring messages to their skating friends and family.
- o 25% of any Message Bubble solicited by a skating members goes towards fundraising goal
- o All Ad Sales due April 8th 2023

Scrip Program

- Buy online gift cards to use online and locally. Use them as gifts to others, to buy groceries, coffee, clothes, and much more.
- Earn a percentage of each gift card purchased.
- 85% of funds earned using Scrip can be used towards fundraising goal or class and ice registrations.
- o Valid for the entire 22 23 season.

Requirements

Home Club Members: 16 Hours or \$300 buyout

Home Club Members (1st yr only): 10 hours or \$150 buyout

Secondary Members: 10 hours or \$150 buyout

All checks made out to SFFSC are due in the black mailbox or mailed to (4300 N Bobhalla Dr. SF, SD 57107) on the wall near the south rink by 9/15/22.

Skaters will **NOT** be permitted to skate prior to submitting all required checks.

 - **1hr** of volunteer time for families with high school sophomores or juniors will be dedicated to show teardown.
 - 25+ available volunteer hours

All volunteer opportunity sign ups will be done through Sign Up Genius specific to each event

Note: If skater participates in show: 1 hrs required per show event. If a skater participates in a club competition a minimum of 3 volunteer hours must be completed at that specific event. All volunteer hours must be completed by May 15th 2023 or buyout check will be cashed on May 16th 2023.
