Requirements

Home Club Members: \$150 per family *Aspire Members:* \$50 per family

We are very excited to announce we are moving the Fundraiser and Volunteer Fee Deposits to electronic tracking and payment for this season. This will replace our previous process of requiring a written check for these requirements and give you the ability to view your balance and see your credits applied throughout the year.

In your account, you will find an invoice that contains both the Fundraiser and Volunteer Fee Deposit. This invoice is dated 6/1/24 and will stay in pending status and not be processed until this date. This invoice will only process for the full amount if the requirement is not met and will only process partial amounts if you have earned a portion of that requirement.

Members will be allowed to pay for any shortages until May 6.2024 . Fundraising invoices for the full amount will be processed if the minimum is not met or shortage paid by May 9th 2024.
