2025-26 SFFSC Fundraising Requirements & Opportunities

Requirements

Home Club Members: \$175 per family Secondary Members: \$75 per family Aspire Members: \$50 per family



Fundraiser and Volunteer Fee Deposits are tracked and payment is processed electronically through an Invoice in your SFFSC account. This gives you the ability to view your balance and see your credits applied throughout the year. In your account, you will find an invoice that contains both the Fundraiser and Volunteer Fee Deposit. This invoice is dated 6/1/26 and will stay in pending status and not be processed until this date. This invoice will only process for the full amount if the requirement is not met; and will only process partial amounts if you have earned a portion of that requirement.

Members will be allowed to pay for any shortages until May 1,2026. Fundraising invoices will be due and processed on June 1, 2026, for the full amount if no requirements are met or for the remaining balance if there are any partial balances remaining.

Fundraising Opportunities

Skate-A-Thon

- o Get family, friends, and neighbors to sponsor your athlete to achieve their skating goals within the hour. (Example: 50 laps, 10 axles, 20 sit spins)
- o 25% of sponsorships (or donations) you secure (up to \$20 per skater) will be used to cover ice time; the remaining will be applied to your fundraising requirement. (Example: Skater secures \$150 in sponsorships. \$20 will be applied to cover ice time; \$130 will be applied to the skater's fundraising requirement.)

SIOUX FALLS FIGURE SKATING CLUB

Families are required to volunteer at events throughout the season. If participating in a club event such as the holiday show, competition, or Annual Spring Show, each family must volunteer (see requirements below). If this requirement is not met, \$200 for each event will be assessed and deducted from your total buyout. In addition, there are many opportunities in which your athlete can also complete volunteer hours. It takes many hands to make light work of hosting these memorable opportunities for our athletes, and we cannot do it without volunteers. Thank you for doing your part to help make this season a fun and successful one.

 - o Announcer, music player, check-in table, decoration crew, awards, ice monitor, hospitality room, runners.
 - o If participating in the Sioux Falls Challenge Cup, each family must volunteer for a minimum of 2 shifts. If this requirement is not met, \$200 will be assessed and taken from your total buyout
 - o 250+ available volunteer hours
- Annual Spring Show May 2, 2026 (Dress rehearsal May 1, 2026)
 - o Announcer, music player, locker room attendant (must be safesport certified), rink side monitor, admission, decorating crew, raffle baskets, bake sale, flowers.
 - o If participating in the Annual Spring Show, each family must volunteer for a minimum of 2.0 hours. If this requirement is not met, \$200 will be assessed and taken from your total buyout
 - o 350+ available volunteer hours
- Volunteer Coaching and Skater Council
 - o Volunteer opportunities that your skaters can do to be more involved in the club and work toward your required hours. Visit sffsc.com/coaches/volunteer-coach/ for more details
